

Socko 2.0.0 has officially landed. After some weeks of development and production testing it is time to give 2.0.0 a go. And with this release, the main Socko-package isn't alone anymore. It has become a platform and consists of packages like

- **js-hierarchy**: The main tree wrangler
- **file-hierarchy**: A js-hierarchy implementation for the file system
- **socko-converter-file**: Converting from file-hierarchy to socko trees and back
- **socko-api**: Socko's core doing all the fancy stuff

Also, **grunt-socko** was updated to 2.0.0 and now also completely builds upon the platform and has no relationship with the socko-package (which is actually just a cli frontend for the platform now) anymore (why should it?)
