

Mail footers tend to be a political, rather than a technical thing. Disclaimr uses the widely adopted Milter API to „hook into“ the mail-process of mail servers, that support Milters (that’s basically every modern mailserver – sadly except Exim as it seems). For configuration, it comes with a nice web ui, that enables non-tech-savvy stuff to work with it.
